Committee authority: the Government Affairs Committee, along with any special committees established for that purpose, has the authority to establish MAR's positions for the legislative session in accordance with the MAR Legislative Policy Statement. A designated spokesperson may be authorized by the President to act day-to-day during the legislative session.
